Responsibilities and Qualifications

The University invites applications for a current opening as a tenure-track Assistant Professor of Health Science beginning August, 2017. Candidates should have earned a terminal degree in Health Science, Health Psychology, Public Health, or a closely related discipline. Applicants should have experience with delivering a strong interdisciplinary curriculum in the study of health promotion. The University of the Ozarks values personal attention and collegiality, thus a familiarity with and understanding of a small and residential campus are highly desirable. Undergraduate teaching experience with the ability to teach a variety of courses is preferred.
